"Take the time to cherish our elders, anyway you can. We are so lucky, us as Maskwacis People, to have those that are with us today. To have that knowledge, those stories and our Cree Language, we are so lucky." says Izaiah Swampy-Omeasoo.

This generation of elders holds a vital role within our Nations, as the living archive of our rich heritage, teachings and traditions they have been able to pass on when facing the identity crisis within our people. Their deep-seated knowledge and experience offer invaluable insights into our past, rebuilding generational gaps with stories and cultural experiences that might otherwise be lost. With our last remaining elders, it is important to learn all that we can from them, keeping their spirit alive by

starting as students to one day become the teachers, beginning the cycle of knowledge keeping. Through their guidance and personal involvement, they impart essential values and historical context, helping younger generations appreciate and understand their roots.

Maskwacis Education Schools Commission hosted their Kehtehyak Forum, inviting Maskwacis elders to come and be apart of the conversation when it comes to our education system and how we, as Nations, want our children to be brought up. The purpose of this forum was to involve those who have walked before us, molding our youth into future elders. With the guidance of our kehtehyak, we can create that spark needed to rebuild and strengthen our homefires.



As a school district, M.E.S.C. aims to focus on the inclusion of our people in the building of our curriculum and Cree Cultural Values. The involvement of parents and elders in the education system is encouraged by staff, as the shared goal is to surround our children in their culture, accept their differences and embrace them with compassion. It is important to attend these forums, as it gives you a closer look into the programs your children will experience, how the language will be implemented, and meet the people you have trusted to lead your children down the path of education.

Thank you so much to everyone who attended the forum, the event was a huge success with your involvement. We hope to see more of these events from M.E.S.C. very soon!

Ermineskin External Affairs and Governance Department purpose is to maintain and protect ECN Inherent and Rights Treaty and interests, overseeing and directing the legal and governance initiatives of the Nation. The key programs and services provided include National and Regional External Restorative Justice. Affairs. Tribal Law/Treaty Protectorate, Membership, Lands, and Post Secondary Support Program.

The External Affair and Governance Division consists of the following departments and their main contact:

- External Affairs and Governance (Collin and Robert)
- Tribal Law / Litigation
- Membership Department (Karman Cutarm, Manager)
- Post Secondary Support Program (Elinor Roan, Manager)
- Lands Department (Daniel Wildcat, Manager)
- Restorative Justice (**Blaine Raine**, Advisor)

The External Affairs Division currently has many projects underway, from the ECN level to the international level.

- This may become a new class action on behalf of all FN Citizens on rural water wells.




